# WHY BECOME AN AU PAIR?



## LIVE ABROAD AT LITTLE COST

Hardly any other program is as affordable as the Au pair program if you want to live in another country for a longer period of time. For a small program fee, you will receive extensive preparation and support as well as free board and lodging from your host family. In addition, you will receive pocket money of up to 800€ per month (see page 15), which you can use for shopping, leisure activities or for your travel expenses. In your free time and after the program, you will have plenty of time to travel as you please and discover your host country. For this purpose, you will have a full month of travel in the USA and up to 6 months in Australia and New Zealand, depending on the length of the program.



## REGULATED CONDITIONS

The au pair program is subject to strict regulations in all host countries, which are bound to the visa by the respective governments. There are rules and regulations for both the au pairs and the host families, which serve not only to guide, but also to provide security for everyone involved.



## A SECOND HOME

As an au pair, you are not only a special caregiver for your guest children, but also a permanent member of the family. Together with your host parents you will share many beautiful and special moments. Maybe you will be there when your youngest guest child takes his or her first step, or play the tooth fairy when your "big one" has lost a tooth! Your social contacts will not be neglected abroad either. You will make friends with other au pairs or with "locals" you meet in your free time or through your host family. Many au pairs make friends during their adventure abroad that last a lifetime!





## A PLUS FOR YOUR RESUME




Stays abroad have become an integral part of the curriculum vitae. They increase your future job chances and prove that you are able to deal with challenging situations.

As an au pair you will experience many exciting moments and learn to master tasks that will help you grow.



# LIFE AS AN AU PAIR

**Together with your host parents you will take care of the children in the family. Your exact tasks depend on the age of your host children and the job situation of the parents. As an au pair, your organizational talent and multitasking skills are especially in demand: You are a caregiver, cook, play partner, comforter, chaos manager and chauffeur all in one!**

In the life of an au pair, no two days are alike. To give you a small impression of what everyday life can look like, our former participant Daria will show you a typical day in her life as an au pair. She lived in Boston for one year and looked after two boys (5 and 2 years) and a little girl (2 months).

## 7:40

**Time to get up!** My day usually starts between 7 and 8 o'clock.

## 8:00

**Breakfast Time.** Before I drive my boys to school, I make breakfast for all of them. Of course, the lunch boxes need to be prepared.

## 8:00 – 9:00

**Off to the car and to school.** One after the other I take the boys to their school buses. When everyone has been dropped off safely, I drive with the little one back to my second home.

## 9:00 – 12:00

After the first bottle and diaper change, I put my little one to bed. The first nap of the day is on the program. While she sleeps, I take care of smaller "**household tasks**" like washing clothes and cleaning the dishes.

## 12:00

Time to get the youngest one **out of school**. At home I prepare a small snack for him. For the baby it is now "naptime" again.

## 12:30 – 17:00

**Free time for the three of us.** Play dates with other au pairs near me, visits to the library or just playing at home or in the garden. There is always something to do and I am completely free with the planning.

## 17:00

My big boy finally finishes school and has to be picked up. Most of the time we also pick up his dad from the station.

## 17:50

When everyone is back home, I finally finish working for the day! I either stay at home and relax or meet up with friends in the city.

In general, **my free time** here is not too short. Weekend trips, shopping tours, au pair meetings in a café or cinema with friends. The **weekends and vacations** that I have free give me a lot of time for myself, which I can arrange very flexibly.

As an au pair in the USA, you have the unique opportunity to experience the "American way of life" first-hand. In your American home, you can get to know the country and its people much better than if traveling as a tourist. Together with your host family you will experience many highlights: You will probably eat the traditional turkey on Thanksgiving, dress up with your host children for Halloween and celebrate American Independence Day. There is no better way of getting to know a country!


Since a large part of the program costs are covered by the families in the USA, you will only have to cover minimal costs for support and placement. There are no additional fees for airfare or insurance.

Only in the USA will you have a personal contact person (Area Director) who will meet you once a month with other au pairs in the region and who will help you with any questions you may have.

# BENEFITS: USA

The au pair program in the USA is regulated by the U.S. Department of State. Fixed conditions such as a minimum amount of pocket money, clearly defined tasks and working hours offer au pairs additional security. The only way to become an au pair in the USA is always through a recognized exchange organization and cannot be organized by the au pairs themselves. AuPairCare has been an official and experienced visa sponsor for au pairs for over 30 years.

## FREE CHOICE OF AIRPORT

You do not have to pay anything extra - neither for your outbound flight to the USA, nor for the return flight to your home country upon successful completion of the program.



### SPECIAL HIGHLIGHT:

Your return flight from the USA does not have to start directly from the airport near your host family. With us, you choose one of about 100 selected departure airports in the USA and can plan your travel month accordingly - at no additional cost.

## EXTEND YOUR STAY

You don't want to leave the land of your dreams at the end of the year? As an au pair in the USA you have the option to extend your stay for another 6, 9 or 12 months for a small fee. Your travel month at the end of the program is not affected.

## START WITH 17

You have the opportunity to complete your application and start the placement process at the age of 17. You don't have to wait until you are 18, but you can already find your host family at the age of 17. That way your adventure abroad can start right after your 18th birthday!

## VISIT A REAL U.S. COLLEGE

The U.S. Department of State requires that au pairs study in the U.S. and take courses at a college or other educational institution. This is a great way for you to gain new skills, experience the college atmosphere and make new friends. You will receive up to US\$500 in tuition fees from your host family. Whether you want to study foreign languages, further education in arts or courses with a connection to the USA: You have the choice and can decide for yourself what you want to do!

## ONLINE PORTAL: DO EVERYTHING FAST AND DIGITALLY

Your application is quick and easy! Thanks to our password-protected online portal "MyAuPairCare" you can complete all important steps from application to host family matching completely online. Here you can find your flight details, training videos for preparation, contact addresses, tips and information about your region in the USA, the international driver's license, taxes and visa. After successful completion of the program, you will also receive your certificate to download.

In the USA we do not work with a partner organization, but with our American colleagues from the main office in San Francisco. With our support network in many regions of the United States, we are personally there for you. From your application to your return, your complete adventure is always in good hand!

# VIRTUAL ACADEMY

Before you fly to your host family in the USA, you will receive access to AuPairCare's Virtual Academy. We prepare you for your time in the USA and you will learn a lot about life as an au pair.

## WELL TRAINED FOR ADVENTURE

Whoever looks after children takes on a really big responsibility. Together with experts, AuPairCare has developed a training program especially for prospective au pairs to make you feel safe and ready for the big adventure:

## THE VIRTUAL ACADEMY

In exciting online seminars and live workshops you will learn about development-specific learning games and topics such as time management as an au pair, safety with children in everyday life, first aid, dealing with homesickness and the first encounter with the host family. You get access to the Academy directly after you have matched with your host family. That way you will have enough time to work through the individual modules of the Academy. The content is tailored to the age of your host children, that way only relevant information for you is covered in your Virtual Academy.

## AU PAIR COMMUNITY

In addition to relevant information regarding childcare the AuPairCare Virtual Academy is also a place to meet other au pairs. Online events take place on a regular basis so that you can get in touch with other au pairs and talk about your experiences.

## AUPAIRCARE USA

While in the USA you will be supported by our AuPairCare staff. Your Area Director will live a max. car drive of 1.5 hours away from you and your host family and organizes monthly meetings with other au pairs. This way you will also meet au pairs during your year, with whom you can arrange coffee- or play dates.






### YOUR HOST FAMILY



Host families and au pairs are free to agree to a weekly stipend even higher than the \$215 per week minimum. AuPairCare continues to adhere to all U.S. Department of State regulations.

# OUR HOST FAMILIES

Our host families choose to welcome an au pair for various reasons. Many families in which both parents are employed wish to have flexible and trustworthy care for their children. Au pairs are much more than babysitters: they are part of the family and build a very special relationship of trust with the host parents and the children. Most of our host families especially appreciate the cultural exchange that the au pair program offers. They see it as a special opportunity to get to know a young person from another country and to "bring" access to a different culture into their home for themselves and their children.

## What do the host families look like?

Our host families are as colorful and diverse as the populations of Australia or the USA. Therefore, a family does not necessarily always mean "mother-father-child", but can have the most diverse set ups.

However, a large proportion of these are host families with two parents and two to four children who are between three months and ten years old. We have many families in our program who regularly and enthusiastically host au pairs. But also "newcomers" decide to welcome a young person into the family as a caregiver for their children.

## Where are the most au pairs placed?

We place au pairs in families of different ethnic origins and religious affiliations. Most au pair families live in single-family homes in the suburbs of larger cities.

In the USA, the majority of our au pairs live in beautiful California. In Australia, most families live in the greater Sydney or Melbourne area but rural placements are also possible.

## How is my family selected?

After the successful interview, we will send your application to the AuPairCare office in San Francisco or to our respective partner organizations.

Each host family is carefully selected and checked. Just as you apply as an au pair and have to meet the requirements, the families have to apply and qualify for the program in return.

## What happens after the matching?

As soon as a host family wants to meet you, you will receive an email with their profile and you can contact each other. Once you have decided on each other, you and your host family decide on your arrival date. You can leave the country during the whole year.

## Can I change my family if necessary?

Yes, in consultation with our local colleagues, this possibility exists. If you notice that the chemistry is not right and you just can't go on together, you have the possibility to talk to host families again and inspire them with your enthusiasm. In most cases, the change of host family is successful. However, there is no guarantee that you will find a new family. In principle, a change should therefore be considered as a last option and only after a detailed discussion with your host family and your local counselor.
